

St Mary's School Remote Learning Plan

Please note: This plan and the class specific programs will change as we develop delivery in this environment

In response to the unprecedented circumstances brought about by the COVID-19 pandemic, St Mary's School has developed a remote learning plan to ensure your child continues to receive the best possible education. Through our established systems, we can utilise online tools for communication and educational delivery.

It is important to note that as parents, we do not expect that students will complete the same level of work as a standard school day.

Please look for opportunities to make learning fun and engaging, get outside, play games with your children. The most important take-away from this experience is to remain positive.

The main delivery methods of the curriculum include:

- 1. Teams: Microsoft Teams will be used to communicate, collaborate and organise systems of work to the students. This will also be used to store files and resources required for activities.
- 2. Seesaw: Seesaw will be used for communication and transmission of finished and unfinished work. It may also be used for assessment purposes.
- 3. Work Packs: In the absence of digital curriculum delivery or if the age of students means digital delivery is not appropriate, work packs will be created. These are related to current curriculum content and levelled appropriately for the child.

Online learning will be delivered during school hours from 8:50-3:10. Contact outside of this time will be on a case by case basis.

Safe Online Learning:


