

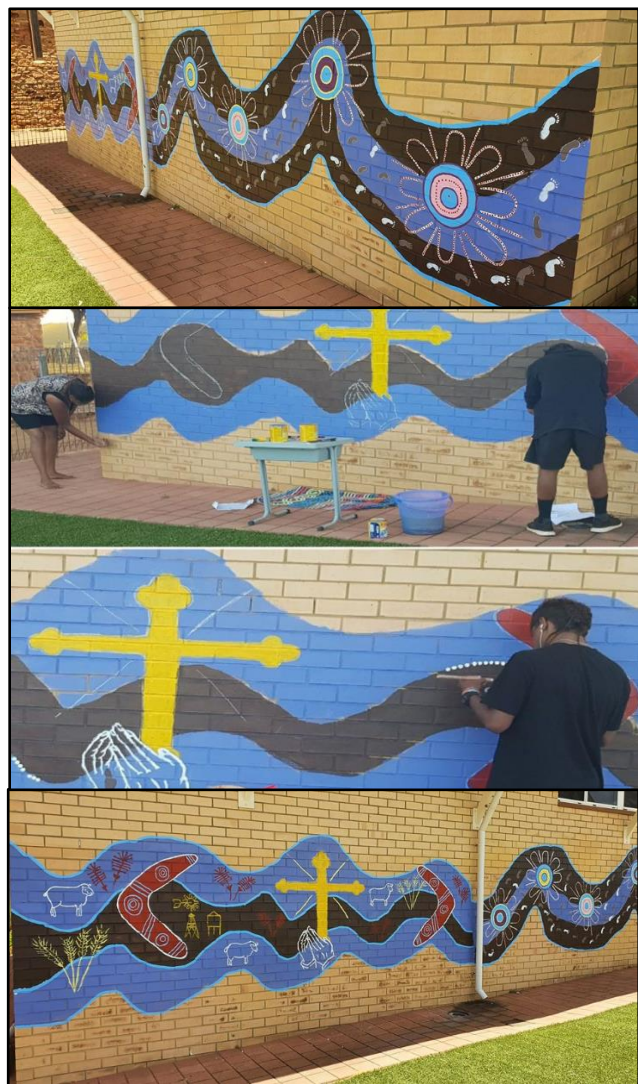
I would like to welcome all our community members back to another exciting year at St Mary's. We have hit the ground running this year and as always, our children have made our start a magnificent one!
